**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2015-19**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON  
AMENDING THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF  
THE COVINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES:  
CHAPTER 6 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE II.  
BEVERAGES OF HIGH ALCOHOLIC CONTENT AND  
ARTICLE III. BEVERAGES OF LOW ALCOHOLIC CONTENT,  
TO ADD SECTIONS 6-46 AND 6-86 LOCATION EXEMPTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, certain amendments have been suggested to the section of the Code addressing exemptions to the alcoholic beverage location restrictions within City limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Covington City Council deems these amendments appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Covington; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has held its public hearing in accordance with law,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Covington, at its regular session convened, that Chapter 6 Alcoholic Beverages, Article II. Beverages of High Alcoholic Content, shall be amended to add Section 6-46 as follows:

**Sec. 6-46. Location Exemption.**

The restrictions contained in Section 6-42 do not apply to premises which are or will be established to be maintained and operated as a restaurant and/or bona fide hotel.

**Secs. 6-47—6-70. Reserved.**

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Covington, at its regular session convened, that Chapter 6 Alcoholic Beverages, Article III. Beverages of Low Alcoholic Content, shall be amended to add Section 6-86 as follows:

1 **Sec. 6-86. Location Exemption.**

2  
3 The restrictions contained in Section 6-42 do not apply to premises which are or  
4 will be established to be maintained and operated as a restaurant and/or bona fide  
5 hotel.

7 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all other sections of Chapter 6 shall  
8 remain the same and in full force.

9 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision of this ordinance  
10 shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein  
11 which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the  
12 provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

13 **WHEREUPON**, this ordinance having been submitted in writing, having  
14 been read by title and adopted at a public meeting of the City Council of the City  
15 of Covington, State of Louisiana, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole,  
16 the vote thereon being as follows:


