ORDINANCE NUMBER 2014- 15

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON
DECLARING SURPLUS, FIXING THE MINIMUM PRICE,
AND AUTHORIZING SALE OF EQUIPMENT**

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14 **WHEREAS**, a certain piece of equipment, specifically a DuraPatcher, is no
15 longer used or needed for public purposes by the Public Works Department; and

16 **WHEREAS**, this piece of equipment, namely the DuraPatcher, should be
17 declared a surplus item; and

18 **WHEREAS**, a minimum price for said surplus item, namely the
19 DuraPatcher; should be set at the amount of SIXTY THOUSAND AND NO/100
20 (\$60,000.00) DOLLARS; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Amite County, Mississippi located
22 in Osyka, Mississippi has offered SIXTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$60,000.00)
23 DOLLARS for the said piece of equipment, namely the DuraPatcher; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Covington City Council deems the sale of this surplus item
25 to Amite County, Mississippi, to be in the best interest of the City and its citizens;
26 and

27 **WHEREAS**, notice of said sale of surplus item has been advertised in the
28 City's official journal for the required time period as per Louisiana Revised Statute
29 §33:4712, and

30 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has held its public hearing in accordance with
31 law,

32 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City
33 of Covington, at its regular session convened, that the said piece of equipment,
34 namely the DuraPatcher, be hereby declared a surplus item; and

35 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the purchase price for the said surplus
36 item, namely the DuraPatcher, be set at SIXTY THOUSAND AND NO/100
37 (\$60,000.00) DOLLARS, and

1 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the sale of said surplus item, namely
2 the DuraPatcher, to the County of Amite, Mississippi is in the best interest of the
3 City of Covington and its citizens, and

4 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision of this ordinance
5 shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein
6 which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the
7 provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

8 **WHEREUPON**, this ordinance having been submitted in writing, having
9 been read by title and adopted at a public meeting of the City Council of the City
10 of Covington, State of Louisiana, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole,
11 the vote thereon being as follows:
