10 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON**
11 **AMENDING THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF THE**
12 **COVINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES: CHAPTER 66**
13 **OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS, ARTICLE**
14 **IV. OFFENSES AFFECTING PUBLIC MORALS, TO ADD A**
15 **NEW SECTION 66-115. OPEN CONTAINERS ON CLASS B**
16 **PREMISES PROHIBITED**

19 **WHEREAS**, a certain amendment has been suggested to the section of the
20 Code addressing offenses affecting public morals; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Covington City Council deems this amendment
22 appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Covington;
23 and

24 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has held its public hearing in accordance with
25 law,

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City
27 of Covington, at its regular session convened, that Chapter 66 Offenses and
28 Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV. Offenses Affecting Public Morals, shall be
29 amended to add the following section:

30 Sec. 66-115. Open containers on Class B premises prohibited.
31 It shall be unlawful for any person to possess an open container of alcoholic
32 beverage on any premises for which a Class B liquor license has been issued. The
33 term "premises" in this section shall include the licensed premises and the property
34 upon which the licensed premises is located, including the parking lot.

36 Whoever violates the provisions of this Section shall be punished as provided in
37 Section 1-8 of this code.

39 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all other sections of Chapter 66
40 Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions shall remain the same and in full force.

41 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision of this ordinance
42 shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein
43 which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the
44 provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.


