INTRODUCTION

THE CITY OF COVINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-08

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SURPLUS A CERTAIN VEHICLE,  
SCRAP METAL AND EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE CITY OF  
COVINGTON**

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the property described is no longer needed for the public purposes of the City of Covington, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council for the City of Covington, to comply with Louisiana state law regarding the disposition of surplus property, and

WHEREAS, the value of any item of said movable property does not exceed \$5,000.00, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council for the City of Covington, Louisiana, in regular session convened that the movable property described in attached Exhibit A is hereby declared not needed for public use and therefore surplus, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said surplus property be disposed of pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 33:4712, and that should no bids be received on any item of surplus property, the Director of Administration is authorized to sell such surplus movable property as scrap.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

This ordinance having been submitted in writing, having been read by title and adopted at a public meeting of the City Council of the City of Covington, State of Louisiana, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows.
