 10 **WHEREAS**, the original 2011 Recreation Capital Budget as adopted
 11 did not include a sufficient appropriation for restroom facilities at Hubie
 12 Gallagher Park; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the original 2011 Recreation Capital Budget as adopted
 14 did not include a sufficient appropriation for lawn mowing equipment for the
 15 Covington Recreation Complex; and

16 **WHEREAS**, funds are available in the 2011 Recreation Capital
 17 Budget for the above mentioned purposes; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the City Council and Mayor recognize the need to fund
 19 these projects; and

20 **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend the 2011 Recreation Capital
 21 Budget as follows:
