**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON
NAMING THE ALLEY CONNECTING NORTH HARRISON
STREET AND NORTH TYLER STREET BETWEEN WEST 22ND
AVENUE AND WEST 23RD AVENUE AS ROSS ALLEY**

WHEREAS, the alley connecting North Harrison Street and North Tyler Street between West 22nd Avenue and West 23rd Avenue is a dedicated but unnamed alley; and

WHEREAS, the City of Covington has received the attached request from Mark Johnson in which he has requested this alley be named “Ross Alley;” and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Covington Code of Ordinances, Sec. 86-10(d), written comments from the City’s police, fire and public works departments, along with the Covington Postmaster and the St. Tammany Parish Communications District (“911”), have been requested and no objections have been received; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held its public hearing in accordance with law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Covington, at its regular session convened, that the dedicated but unnamed alley connecting North Harrison Street and North Tyler Street between West 22nd Avenue and West 23rd Avenue shall be named “Ross Alley.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein that can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
