7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON
8 AMENDING THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF THE
9 COVINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES: CHAPTER 98
10 UTILITIES, ARTICLE II. SOLID WASTE,
11 DIVISION 2. CITY DUMP AND LANDFILL
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14 WHEREAS, certain amendments have been suggested to the sections of the
15 Code addressing the City dump and landfill; and

16 WHEREAS, the Covington City Council deems these amendments
17 appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Covington;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the City Council has held its public hearing in accordance with
20 law,

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City
22 of Covington, at its regular session convened, that Chapter 98 Utilities, Article II.
23 Solid Waste, Division 2. City Dump and Landfill, shall be amended to read as
24 follows:

25 ~~DIVISION 2. CITY DUMP AND LANDFILL~~ **DEBRIS SITE.**

26 ~~Sec. 98-46. Entry permits.~~

27 ~~(a) City residents and businesses may without charge deposit trash or garbage at~~
28 ~~the city dump, which trash or garbage is generated by their city residence or~~
29 ~~business, subject to regulations that may be adopted by the sanitation department,~~
30 ~~and provided that the city resident or business has a valid entry permit issued by~~
31 ~~the city.~~

32 ~~(b) Upon request the city shall issue an annual entry permit to any resident of~~
33 ~~the city or business being operated in the city, whose sewer, water, garbage and~~
34 ~~trash fees are current, and whose deposits are made and are in the full amount~~
35 ~~required in this division. Such permits shall be cancelled and invalidated in the~~
36 ~~event of any delinquency in sewer, water, trash or garbage bills, or in the event the~~
37 ~~deposits required in this division fall below the amounts required in this division.~~

38 ~~(c) Any person who is a nonresident of the city or who is a resident of the city~~
39 ~~and who has garbage generated from outside of the city, and any business outside~~
40 ~~the city, may deposit garbage and trash at the city dump which is generated by~~
41 ~~their residences or businesses in the parish but outside the city limits, subject to the~~
42 ~~regulations that may be adopted by the sanitation department, provided that the~~
43 ~~following fees shall be charged:~~

44 ~~Per automobile load . . . \$ 2.00~~

45 ~~Per pickup load . . . 5.00~~

46 ~~Per dump truck load . . . 15.00~~

3 ~~The sanitation department shall adopt rules and regulations which may be amended~~
4 ~~from time to time regarding the use of the dump with respect to hours of operation,~~
5 ~~where materials are to be deposited, what materials are to be accepted or excluded,~~
6 ~~and with respect to such other matters regarding the dump as the sanitation~~
7 ~~department may choose to regulate.~~

9 ~~Sec. 98-48. Prohibiting persons from using.~~

10 ~~Any person or entity, or the person for whom the person works, who violates the~~
11 ~~rules and regulations promulgated by the sanitation department or who violates any~~
12 ~~provisions of this chapter may be prohibited from using the city dump.~~

13 (~~Code 1977, § 19-41~~)

14 ~~Sec. 98-49.~~ **Sec. 98-46.** Depositing trash, etc., in **the former city landfill or**
15 **debris site** prohibited; penalty.

16 (a) No person shall place or deposit any garbage, litter, newspaper or rubbish as
17 defined in section 42-62 or any sewage sludge or any other materials whatsoever
18 on the 80-acre **former city landfill or debris site**, or any other location in the city,
19 except material placed in conformity with the closure plan as approved by the
20 department of environmental quality.

21 (b) Anyone who violates this section shall be subject to those penalties set forth
22 in section 1-8 of the Covington Code of Ordinances.

25 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all other sections of Chapter 98

26 Utilities shall remain the same and in full force.

27 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision of this ordinance

28 shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein
29 which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the
30 provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

31 **WHEREUPON**, this ordinance having been submitted in writing, having


32 been read by title and adopted at a public meeting of the City Council of the City
